Here's What You Need to Know

- Eligibility requirements range from academic achievement to financial need, and areas of interest.
- Scholarship awards range from \$500 to \$2,500.
- Required Documents for the application:
 - High School Transcript
 - FAFSA Submission Summary or IPS FAFSA Opt Out Form
- Application is open from February 26, 2024 - March 15, 2024.
- Scholarship awards will be announced the week of April 8, 2024.
- Scholarships will be sent directly to the postsecondary institution the students plan to attend.
